IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Sabbath Day lake, in the  
town of New Gloucester, Cumberland county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Fishing through the ice for any kind of fish  
2 is hereby prohibited in Sabbath Day lake, situated in the  
3 town of New Gloucester, Cumberland county, under a  
4 penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty  
5 dollars for each offense, and an additional fine of one dollar  
6 for each fish caught, taken or killed in violation of this act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
