STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Sabbath Day lake, in the town of New Gloucester, Cumberland county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Fishing through the ice for any kind of fish 2 is hereby prohibited in Sabbath Day lake, situated in the 3 town of New Gloucester, Cumberland county, under a 4 penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty 5 dollars for each offense, and an additional fine of one dollar 6 for each fish caught, taken or killed in violation of this act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
