STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend "An Act to authorize the city of Portland to
appoint Commissioners of Cemeteries and Public Grounds."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 509 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of Maine 1885, is hereby amended by adding
3 at the end of said section 3 the following:

'Said commissioners are authorized to elect annually a
5 superintendent, who may be one of their number, and who
6 shall perform such duties as the commissioners prescribe.

The commissioners shall set aside a reasonable portion of
8 the appropriation for cemeteries and public grounds as the
9 compensation of said superintendent, and the same shall be

10 paid to him in equal monthly payments,' so that same sec-
11 tion, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Said commissioners shall have charge and control
13 of all the cemeteries, other than evergreen cemetery, together
14 with the parks, promenades, squares and other grounds,
15 which are or may hereafter be reserved for ornamental uses,
16 belonging to the city; and under their direction, all appro-
17 priations made for said cemeteries and grounds, shall be
18 expended. Said commissioners are authorized to elect
19 annually a superintendent who may be one of their number,
20 and who shall perform such duties as the commissioners pre-
21 scribe. The commissioners shall set aside a reasonable por-
22 tion of the appropriation for cemeteries and public grounds
23 as the compensation of said superintendent, and the same
24 shall be paid to him in equal monthly payments.'
