STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to legalize the doings of a meeting of School District
Number 16 in the town of Stonington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The meeting of school district formerly known
2 as school district number 16 in the town of Stonington in the
3 county of Hancock, holden on the twenty-fifth day of August
4 in the year nineteen hundred, and the acts and doings of said
5 meeting are hereby made legal and valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
