IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the laying out of a way across the tide  
waters of Piscataqua river in Kittery.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. A town way or a highway may be laid out,  
2 constructed and maintained in the manner provided in  
3 chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes, across and over  
4 the tide waters of Piscataqua river between the mainland  
5 at Kittery and Badger's island, so-called, in said Kittery,  
6 upon and over the existing bridge of the Portsmouth,  
7 Kittery and York Street Railway across said river.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
