STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-two of chapter one hundred
and twenty-two of the Revised Statutes, relating to falsely
assuming to be a justice or officer.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 22 of chapter 122 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "constable" in the
3 second line the words 'or inland fish and game warden or
4 a commissioner of inland fisheries and game,' so that said
5 section as amended shall read as follows :

'Sect. 22. Whoever falsely assumes to be a justice of
7 the peace, sheriff, deputy sheriff, coroner, or constable'

8 or inland fish and game warden, or a commissioner of
9 inland fisheries and game, and to act as such, or to require
10 any one to aid him in a matter pertaining to the duty of
11 such office, shall be punished by imprisonment for less than
12 one year, or by fine not exceeding four hundred dollars.'
