IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Bluehill and Bucksport Electric Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the

2 Bluehill and Bucksport Electric Railroad Company, which

3 were granted by chapter one hundred and fifty-seven of

4 the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and

5 ninety-nine, are hereby extended for two years additional;

6 and the persons named in said act, their associates and

7 successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges

8 that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the

9 same manner and for the same purposes as specified in 10 said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
