IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Ellsworth Street Rail-  
way Company.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter 391 of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of 1889, entitled "An Act to Incorporate  
3 the Ellsworth Street Railway Company" is hereby amended  
4 by adding at the close of said section one, the following  
5 words: 'Said company is also authorized hereby to build  
6 construct, equip, maintain and operate one or more branch  
7 lines extending from any point on its main lines within the  
8 limits of said city of Ellsworth, to any points within the  
9 towns of Trenton and Lamoine, in said county of Han-  
10 cock, with all the several privileges, and subject to all the  
11 provisions and restrictions made applicable to said cor-  
12 poration.'

Sect. 2. The rights, powers and privileges of said  
2 Ellsworth Street Railway Company which were granted  
3 by chapter 391 of the Private and Special Laws for the  
4 year 1889, as extended and enlarged by chapter 515 of  
5 the Private and Special Laws for the year 1893, chapter  
6 81 of the Private and Special Laws for the year 1895,  
7 chapter 456 of the Private and Special Laws for the year  
8 1897, and chapter 133 of the Private and Special Laws  
9 for the year 1899, are hereby extended for two years  
10 additional, and the persons named in said acts, their asso-  
11 ciates and successors shall have the rights, powers and  
12 privileges that were granted to them by said acts, to be  
13 exercised for the same purposes as specified in said acts.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
