STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of trout in Hancock County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch
2 or kill any trout in any of the waters lying wholly or
3 partly in the county of Hancock for sale.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, at any
2 time, to sell, either directly or indirectly, any trout in
3 Hancock county.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a fine of not more than thirty nor
3 less than ten dollars for each offense, and an additional
4 fine of one dollar for each trout taken, caught, killed or
5 sold in violation of this act.
