Resolved, That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars be and

- 4 the comissioner of sea and shore fisheries under the direction
- 5 of the governor and council.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is in the usual form of the resolves adopted by the legislature upon this subject and is for the same amount that has been appropriated by the last two preceding legislatures while a much larger amount than the resolve carries might be used with good results in this department, under the present conditions the requirements of the department can be carried out with the amount for which this resolve calls.
