IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to repeal the organization of Perkins Plantation in
Franklin County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The organization of Perkins plantation in
2 Franklin county is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
