IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to set off Calf island and West Black island from
the Plantation of Long Island in the County of Hancock,
and annex the same to the Town of Swan's Island.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Calf island and West Black island are hereby
2 set off from the plantation of Long Island in the county of
3 Hancock, and the same are hereby annexed to and made a
4 part of the town of Swan's Island in said county.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
