## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of O. B. Clason of Gardiner, Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of forty-five dollars is hereby 2 appropriated, to be paid to O. B. Clason of Gardiner, exe-3 cutor of estate of late William Cowell; the same being for 4 over payment to the state, of collateral inheritance tax, from 5 said estate.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

By an error in computing the collateral inheritance tax in estate of William Cowell, there was paid to the state treasurer the sum of one hundred and seventy-five dollars, when in reality, as shown by the certificate of the judge of probate of Kennebec county, there should have been paid only the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars. This resolve calls for the payment to the executor of said estate, the sum of forty-five dollars, the amount overpaid.
