STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY HOUSE  
DOCUMENT No. 141.

The petitioner Howard Whittier's time of service in the civil war lacked a few days of entitling him to a United States or a State pension, therefore he is compelled to ask aid by special act. He is old, feeble and unable to perform any labor. His resources including the two dollars per month pension granted by the Legislature, are insufficient for the maintenance of himself and wife, and unless he is allowed additional aid he will become a subject of public or private charity.
