### STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

A'N ACT to amend section two of chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, as amended by chapter forty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, relating to the Fort Fairfield Village Corporation.

# Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the

- 2 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-
- 3 seven, as amended by chapter forty of the Private and Special
- 4 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, is hereby
- 5 amended by adding after the words "sprinkling streets" in

6 the eighth line of said section the words 'and for lighting 7 streets,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized and vested 9 with power at any legal meeting called for the purpose, to 10 raise money to purchase, repair and preserve one or more 11 fire engines, and all other necessary apparatus for the extin-12 guishment of fires, to build and repair engine houses, to con-13 struct reservoirs and aqueducts, to contract with individuals 14 or corporations for a supply of water for the extinguishment 15 of fires and for sprinkling streets, and for lighting streets, 16 and to maintain within said limits an efficient fire depart-17 ment, to defray the expenses of a night watch, a police force, 18 and all other necessary measures for the better security of 19 life and property, and the promotion of good order and quiet 20 within its limits.'
