RESOLVE for State Pensions.

Resolved, That the sum of eighty thousand dollars be and 2 is hereby appropriated to provide for state pensions for 3 invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows and orphans, and 4 the dependent children, parents and sisters of deceased 5 soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under existing law, for 6 the year nineteen hundred and one, and eighty thousand dol-7 lars for the year nineteen hundred two.
