STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide means for examination of claims for
State Pension.

Resolved, That the state pension clerk is hereby authorized to expend such sum under the direction of the governor and council, not exceeding four hundred dollars yearly, as may be necessary to properly examine the claims presented to his office, the same to be paid out of the appropriation for state pensions for the years nineteen hundred one and nineteen hundred two.
