STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit winter fishing in Great Watchic pond, and regulating the time for fishing in the tributaries of the same.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for 2 fishing in Great Watchic pond, and its tributaries, situated 3 in the town of Standish, from the first day of October to 4 the first day of the following May of each year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to the same penalties as provided in the 3 general law for illegal fishing.
