STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT fixing the amount of allowance for clerk hire in
the office of the Adjutant General.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after January first, nineteen hun-
2 dred and one, the amount allowed for clerk hire in the
3 office of the adjutant general shall be eighteen hundred
4 dollars per annum, payable quarterly, instead of the sum
5 now provided by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
