STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to the Taxation of Street Railroad
Companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter six of the
2 Revised Statutes as amended by chapter forty-four of the
3 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five is hereby
4 amended so that the same shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 47. Street railroad corporations and associations are
6 subject to the six preceding sections and to section four,
7 except that the tax shall be ascertained as follows: When
8 the gross average receipts per mile do not exceed one thou-
9 sand dollars the tax shall be equal to three-twentieths of one

10 per cent. on the gross transportation receipts; and for each
11 thousand dollars additional gross receipts per mile, or frac-
12 tional part thereof, the rate shall be increased three-twentieths
13 of one per cent.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
