## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to the Taxation of Street Railroad Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter six of the
- 2 Revised Statutes as amended by chapter forty-four of the
- 3 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five is hereby
- 4 amended so that the same shall read as follows:
  - 'Sect. 47. Street railroad corporations and associations are
- 6 subject to the six preceding sections and to section four,
- 7 except that the tax shall be ascertained as follows: When
- 8 the gross average receipts per mile do not exceed one thou-
- 9 sand dollars the tax shall be equal to three-twentieths of one

10 per cent. on the gross transportation receipts; and for each 11 thousand dollars additional gross receipts per mile, or frac12 tional part thereof, the rate shall be increased three-twentieths 13 of one per cent.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
