## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the compilation and publication of the  
Insurance Laws of Maine.

---

*Resolved*, That the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)  
2 be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of compiling  
3 the insurance and fraternal beneficiary laws of the state,  
4 and the insurance commissioner is hereby authorized to make  
5 such compilation and cause two thousand (2000) copies of  
6 the same to be printed and bound for the use of his depart-  
7 ment.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The last compilation of the insurance laws of this state is the edition of 1895, which was compiled soon after the adjournment of the legislature of that year. This edition is entirely exhausted and the accompanying resolve is to enable the insurance commissioner to supply the constant demand for the statutes of this state relating to insurance.
