IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Maine and New Hampshire Granite Company to maintain a tramway across a county road in the town of Jay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

For the purposes of its granite business the Maine and New

- 2 Hampshire Granite Company is hereby authorized to con-
- 3 struct and maintain an overhead tramway across the county
- 4 road in the town of Jay leading from North Jay postoffice
- 5 to Livermore Falls at a point in said road where said com-
- 6 pany crosses with its finished and unfinished stock; said
- 7 tramway to be built and maintained according to the reason-
- 8 able requirements of the municipal officers of said town of
- 9 Jay.
