### STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT amendatory to section twenty of chapter two hundred forty-two of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of South Portland."

# Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty of chapter two hundred forty-two of the

- 2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out the following sentence, "This provi-
- 4 sion shall not apply to local tradesmen furnishing supplies
- 5 of any kind in their line to the city," so that said section as
- 6 amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 20. Neither the mayor, members of the board of

- 8 aldermen, or any officer of the city, shall be interested, directly
- 9 or indirectly, in any contract or agreement to which the city 10 is a party.'
