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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT amendatory to section twenty of chapter two hundred forty-two of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of South Portland."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section twenty of chapter two hundred forty-two of the  
2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the following sentence, "This provi-  
4 sion shall not apply to local tradesmen furnishing supplies  
5 of any kind in their line to the city," so that said section as  
6 amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 20. Neither the mayor, members of the board of  
8 aldermen, or any officer of the city, shall be interested, directly  
9 or indirectly, in any contract or agreement to which the city  
10 is a party.'
