STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of York to supply light for public uses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of York is hereby authorized to make 2 such contracts for lighting the streets in any part of said 3 town as the inhabitants thereof, at any meeting called, noti-4 fied and held according to law, may determine.

Sect. 2. Said town may raise money to carry out the pur-2 pose of this act in any method in which money may be raised

3 for ordinary town charges.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
