STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to close Sandy stream and tributaries and the tributaries of Unity pond in the town of Unity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for a term of three years 2 to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish, at any time, 3 in the stream known as Sandy stream or any of its tributaries, 4 or in any of the tributaries of Unity pond, situated in the 5 town of Unity, except that ells and suckers may be taken in 6 their season.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to the same penalties provided for illegal 3 fishing in the general law of the state.
