## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT relating to Trust and Banking Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Every trust and banking company shall set apart

- 2 as a guaranty fund not less than ten per cent of its net earn-
- 3 ings in each and every year until such fund, with the accumu-
- 4 lated interest thereon, shall amount to one-fourth of the cap-
- 5 ital stock of the company. The said surplus shall be kept
- 6 to secure against losses and contingencies, and whenever the
- 7 same becomes impaired it shall be reimbursed in the manner
- 8 provided for its accumulation.

Sect. 2. No such company shall make any loan to its direc-

2 tors, officers, agents or other persons in its employ, until the

- 3 proposition to make such loan shall have been submitted by 4 the person desiring the same to the board of directors of such 5 bank, or to the executive committee of such board, if any, 6 and accepted and approved by a majority of such board or 7 committee. Such approval, if the loan is made, shall be 8 spread upon the records of the corporation; and this record 9 shall, in every instance, give the names of the directors auto thorizing the loan.
- Sect. 3. Such corporations shall not make loans or dis-2 counts on the security of the shares of their own capital stock, 3 nor be the purchasers or holders of any such shares unless 4 necessary to prevent loss upon a debt previously contracted 5 in good faith; and all stock so acquired shall, within a reas-6 onable time after its acquisition, be disposed of at public or 7 private sale.
- Sect. 4. No trust and banking company shall establish a 2 branch or agency in any city or town other than that in which 3 the parent institution has its location until the same be author-4 ized by a special act of the legislature. This provision shall 5 not apply to branches and agencies already established and in 6 operation under existing charter rights.
