STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of sawdust and other mill waste into streams lying wholly, or in part, in the towns of Naples and Raymond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall cast or throw into 2 any of the streams, rivers or brooks lying wholly, or in part, 3 in the towns of Naples and Raymond, in the county of Cum-4 berland, any sawdust, shavings, bark, or other mill waste, or 5 place or deposit such mill waste or other refuse, along the 6 banks in such a manner that the same shall fall or be washed 7 into said brooks or streams.

Sect. 2. Any person violating the provisions of section one 2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five dollars and 3 not more than fifty dollars to be recovered in an action of 4 debt by any party injured, or by indictment.
