IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prevent ice fishing in Little Sebago pond in the
towns of Gray and Windham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill
2 in any way any fish in Little Sebago pond, in the towns of
3 Gray and Windham, from October 1st, to June 15th of each
4 year, under a penalty of not more than thirty dollars nor less
5 than ten dollars for each offense and one dollar additional
6 for each fish caught, taken or killed in violation of this act.
