STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Judge and Register of Probate
for the county of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of May in the year
2 of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and one, the salary
3 of the Judge of Probate of Oxford county shall be five hun-
4 dred fifty (550) dollars a year.

Sect. 2. From and after the first day of May in the year of
2 our Lord one thousand nine hundred and one, the salary of
3 the Register of Probate for Oxford county shall be eight
4 hundred (800) dollars a year.

Sect. 3. The salaries provided in sections 1 and 2 of this
2 act shall be in full for all services and expenses by reason of

3 the four extra terms of Probate Court to be held at Rumford

4 Falls in the town of Rumford.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
