STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend paragraph eight of section six of chapter six of the Revised Statutes as amended by the Public Laws of 1895 relating to poll taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph eight of section six of chapter six 2 of the Revised Statutes as amended by the Public Laws 3 of 1895 is hereby amended by adding the following words 4 after the words "state pension" 'and all honorably dis- 5 charged soldiers and sailors of the war of the rebellion 6 over sixty-five years of age' so said paragraph as amended 7 shall read as follows :

'VIII. The polls and estates of persons who by reason 9 of age, infirmity and poverty are, in the judgement of

10 the assessors unable to contribute towards the public
11 charges; and the polls of all soldiers and sailors who
12 receive a state pension, and all honorably discharged sol-
13 diers and sailors of the war of the rebellion over sixty-five
14 years of age.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
