STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT imposing a franchise tax upon Sleeping and Palace Cars.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Every corporation or person owning or operat-

- 2 ing palace or other cars for which extra compensation is
- 3 charged for riding therein over any of the railroads of the
- 4 state shall on the first day of September next and annually
- 5 thereafter pay to the treasurer of the state for the state an
- 6 annual excise tax for the privilege of exercising its fran-
- 7 chises in the state equal to four per cent of its gross earnings

- 8 from business done in the state of Maine for the year ending 9 June thirtieth next preceding.
 - Sect. 2. Every such corporation or person shall by its
- 2 properly authorized agent or officer annually on or before the
- 3 first day of August make a return under oath to the board of
- 4 state assessors, stating the amount of such gross earnings,
- 5 whereupon the board of state assessors shall on or before the
- 6 fifteenth day of said August assess the tax herein provided
- 7 and forthwith certify the same to the treasurer of state, who
- 8 shall thereupon notify said corporations or persons, and said
- 9 taxes shall be paid into the state treasury on or before the
- 10 first day of September following.
 - Sect. 3. The tax assessed upon said corporations or per-
 - 2 sons as aforesaid is in the place of all local taxation upon the
- 3 cars and equipment used in carrying on business in the state.
- Sect. 4. Any corporation or person neglecting to make
- 2 returns according to section two of this act forfeits twenty-
- 3 five dollars for every day's neglect, to be recovered by action
- 4 of debt in the name of the state.
- Sect. 5. The provisions of section sixty-eight of chapter
- 2 six of the Revised Statutes as amended shall apply to the
- 3 assessment and collection of the tax imposed by this act.
 - Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
