STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to Railroad Crossings.

*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives, in
Legislature assembled:*

Whenever any railroad company of any kind, whose tracks
2 are to be constructed across the tracks of any railroad already
3 built, shall apply to the railroad commissioners to determine
4 in what manner and under what conditions such crossing
5 shall be made, constructed and maintained and how the
6 expense thereof shall be borne and an appeal is taken from
7 the decision of the railroad commissioners thereon, the board
8 of railroad commissioners may, if they find that public neces-
9 sity and convenience require it, notwithstanding said appeal,
10 determine the manner and conditions of construction and
11 maintenance of such crossing during the pendency of said
12 appeal or of any legal proceedings that may delay final decree
13 on said application and shall issue the necessary temporary
14 decree therefor.
