STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT additional to "An Act to incorporate the Union Gas and Electric Company of Waterville and to amend section 4 of chapter 556 of the Private and Special Laws of 1897."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Union Gas and Electric Company, a corpo-

- 2 ration established by law and having its place of business at
- 3 Waterville in the county of Kennebec, is hereby authorized
- 4 and empowered to purchase, hold, own, and dispose of the
- 5 capital stock and bonds in other corporations.
 - Sect. 2. Section 4 of chapter 556 of the Private and Special
- 2 Laws of 1897, creating said corporation is hereby amended

- 3 by inserting after the word "Vassalboro" in the fourth and
- 4 fifteenth lines thereof, the word 'Belgrade,' so that said sec-
- 5 tion as amended shall read as follows:

Said corporation is hereby empowered to set poles 7 and extend wires in and through the streets and ways of the 8 city of Waterville and the towns of Winslow, Benton, Vassal-9 boro, Belgrade and Fairfield, for the purpose of furnishing 10 electric lights for public and private use in said city and 11 towns, under such reasonable restrictions as may be imposed 12 by the municipal officers thereof, subject to the general laws 13 of the state regulating the erection of posts and lines for the 14 purposes of electricity. It is also empowered to transmit 15 electric power for lease or sale to such points in said city and 16 towns as may be feasible, in such manner as may be expe-17 dient, and, subject to the general laws aforesaid, it may erect 18 and maintain all posts, wires, and fixtures necessary therefor. 19 Said corporation shall have the right to lay gas pipes in any 20 of the public streets or highways in said city of Waterville 21 and said towns of Winslow, Benton, Vassalboro, Belgrade 22 and Fairfield; the permit of the municipal officers of said city 23 and towns having first been obtained in writing, and to relay 24 and repair the same, subject to such regulations as the health 25 and safety of the citizens and the security of public travel 26 may require and as may be prescribed by the authorities 27 thereof.'
