STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to further regulate the powers and privileges of street railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any street railroad corporation formed under the general 2 laws of this state or any such corporation organized under 3 a special act of the legislature may be allowed to extend 4 its road to other points or places on application of the 5 board of railroad commissioners and by conforming to the 6 general laws of the state relative to street railroads so far 7 as the same may be applicable.
