## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to allow open time on Deer in certain towns in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to hunt, chase and kill 2 deer in the towns of Baldwin, Bridgton, Casco, Gorham, 3 Gray, Harrison, Naples, New Gloucester, Otisfield, Ray-4 mond, Sebago, Standish and Windham in Cumberland 5 county from October first to November first.

Sect. 2. All the provisions of chapter 30 of the Revised 2 Statutes as amended by chapter 42 of the Public Laws of 2

3 1899, relating to deer, not inconsistent with this act, are4 hereby made a part of this act.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
