IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to allow open time on Deer in certain towns in  
Cumberland County.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to hunt, chase and kill  
2 deer in the towns of Baldwin, Bridgton, Casco, Gorham,  
3 Gray, Harrison, Naples, New Gloucester, Otisfield, Ray-  
4 mond, Sebago, Standish and Windham in Cumberland  
5 county from October first to November first.

Sect. 2. All the provisions of chapter 30 of the Revised  
2 Statutes as amended by chapter 42 of the Public Laws of

3 1899, relating to deer, not inconsistent with this act, are  
4 hereby made a part of this act.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this  
2 act are hereby repealed.
