STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Charles H. Burbank.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury,
2 to Charles H. Burbank of Chesterville, in the county of
3 Franklin, the sum of one hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Charles H. Burbank enlisted in September, 1862, in Co. B, 28th Me. Infantry and was mustered out July 30, 1863, serving his full term of enlistment, nine months. He was mustered out to re-enlist in Co. D, 1st Texas Cavalry and served in that company until the close of the war, when he was honorably discharged. He returned to his native state in January, 1899, and he has never received his state bounty for such service.
