IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT additional to section fifty-nine, chapter three of the
Revised Statutes, relating to city ordinances.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section fifty-nine of chapter three of the Revised Statutes
2 is hereby amended by adding after paragraph XII the
3 following paragraph:

XIII. Cities may establish ordinances requiring all
5 persons selling milk therein to be licensed, and may pre-
6 scribe in such ordinances the terms and conditions upon
7 which such licenses may be granted, when and how such

8 licenses may be revoked, and may prescribe penalties for
9 violations of such ordinances.

No person, unless so licensed, shall sell milk in any city
11 where a license is required as herein provided.
