STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to leagilize and make valid the acts of the town of
Monmouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The act and doings of the town of Monmouth,
2 at its annual meeting held March twelfth, in the year nine-
3 teen hundred, in pursuant of the warrant calling said meet-
4 ing, are hereby made legal and valid, notwithstanding an error
5 in the signing of the copies of said warrant posted by the
6 town constable.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The warrant for the annual town meeting of nineteen hundred was delivered the constable for service. He did not attest the copies posted, although he made his return properly. A number of taxpayers have refused to pay taxes on the ground that the meeting was illegal. The passage of this act by the legislature will relieve the town from the necessity of testing the legality of the meeting by action at law, or sale of the property for the taxes.
