STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Bluehill Trust and Banking Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Blue-

- 2 hill Trust and Banking Company, which were granted by
- 3 chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the Private and
- 4 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and ex-
- 5 tended by chapter three hundred and ninety-one of the Pri-
- 6 vate and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven,
- 7 and further extended by chapter one hundred and thirty of
- 8 the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and nine-
- 9 ty-nine, are hereby extended for two years from the approval

10 of this act; and the persons named in said act, their associates
11 and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privi12 leges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in
13 the same manner and for the same purposes as specified in
14 said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
