IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT relating to prisoners in the County of Sagadahoc.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section nine of chapter seventy, of the Public
2 Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-four, entitled "An act
3 to establish the county of Sagadahoc" is hereby amended
4 by adding thereto the following: 'Said county of Sagadahoc
5 may also make a similar agreement with the county of Andro-
6 scoggin, for the same purposes, and with the same effect,'
7 so that said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. The said county of Sagadahoc is hereby authorized
9 and empowered to make an agreement with the county of
10 Kennebec, upon such terms as may be agreed upon, for the

11 use of the jail of said county of Kennebec, for the purposes
12 and with the same effect mentioned in the preceding section.
13 Said county of Sagadahoc may also make a similar agree-
14 ment with the county of Androscoggin, for the same pur-
15 poses, and with the same effect.'

Sect. 2. The provisions of the eighth and ninth sections
2 of said chapter seventy, as amended by the preceding section,
3 are hereby extended in their effect, until a jail shall be estab-
4 lished and maintained in said county of Sagadahoc.

Sect. 3. Nothing in the foregoing sections shall be so con-
2 strued as to conflict with the general laws of the state relat-
3 ing to the jail system.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
