STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to continue in force chapter two hundred and seventysix of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Van Buren Trust and Banking Company," as amended by chapter one hundred and thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Chapter two hundred and seventy-six of the 2 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-3 five, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Van Buren Trust

4 and Banking Company," as amended by chapter one hun-

5 dred and thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws of 6 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, is hereby continued in 7 force, and the persons named in said act as amended are 8 hereby given a period of two years from the approval of this 9 act in which to organize and commence business under said 10 act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
