# STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend and extend the charter of the Mechanic Falls Banking and Trust Company.

## Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of said act is hereby amended by 2 striking out in the second line of said section the word "fifty" 3 and inserting in the place thereof the words 'twenty-five,' and 4 striking out, in the seventh line of said section the word 5 "fifty" and inserting in the place thereof the words 'twenty-6 five.' So that said section as amended shall read:

'Sect. 4. The capital stock of said corporation shall not 8 be less than twenty-five thousand dollars, divided into shares

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9 of one hundred dollars each, with the right to increase the 10 said capital stock at any time by a vote of the shareholders 11 to any amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars. 12 Said corporation shall not commence business as a trust or 13 banking company, until stock to the amount of at least 14 twenty-five thousand dollars shall have been subscribed and 15 paid, in cash.'

Sect. 2. Section 8 of said act is hereby amended by strik2 ing out in the last line thereof the word "ten" and inserting
3 in the place thereof the word 'five.' So that said section as
4 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 8. No person shall be eligible to the position of a 6 director or trustee of said corporation, who is not the actual 7 owner of five shares of the stock.'

Sect. 3. The time within which the Mechanic Falls Trust 2 and Banking Company must have organized and commenced 3 business under its charter, as hereby amended is hereby ex-4 tended until March 10th, 1905.
