Resolved, That there be paid out of the school fund for the 2 year one thousand nine hundred and one to the town of 3 Kingfield the sum of one hundred thirty-six dollars and 4 fifty-seven cents (\$136.57) being the amount due said town 5 on account of an error in the enumeration of scholars in that 6 town on the 1st day of April last.
