STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT establishing a salary for the Sheriff of Kennebec
county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The sheriff of the county of Kennebec from and
2 after the first day of April, 1901, shall receive as full com-
3 pensation for services in attendance upon the supreme, judi-
4 cial and superior courts in this county, as jailer, master or
5 keeper of the county jail, in said county, for receiving and
6 committing prisoners therein and for the service of all crim-
7 inal processes and performance of all duties relating to the
8 enforcement of all criminal laws, an annual salary of twenty-
9 five hundred dollars a year, to be paid from the county


10 treasury in equal quarterly payments on the last days of
11 March, June, September and December of each year.

The sheriff of said county shall not receive from any of his
13 deputies any of the fees earned by said deputies or any per-
14 centage thereon.

Sect. 2. All fees chargeable under the statutes of this state
2 for the performance of any of the duties prescribed in the
3 preceding section, shall be charged and collected by said
4 sheriff as now provided by law, an accurate account thereof
5 kept and transmitted to the county treasurer on the last days
6 of March, June, September and December annually and the
7 amount deducted from the quarter's salary for the quarter
8 then ending, and the county treasurer shall not pay any
9 quarter's salary until said statement shall have been filed.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the
2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
