## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to regulate the salary of Clerk of Courts of Franklin county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

From and after the first day of April, one thousand nine 2 hundred and one, the clerk of courts for Franklin county 3 shall receive an annual compensation of four hundred dollars, 4 to be paid out of the county treasury of said county, quarterly, on the last days of March, June, September and 6 December, which shall be in full payment for all services of 7 said clerk for which bills have been heretofore ordinarily and 8 properly allowed by the county commissioners of said 9 county; and in addition to the above said clerk shall receive

10 all the other fees of his office as established by law.
