RESOLVE in favor of the town of Madawaska.

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred dollars be and is  
2 hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and two  
3 to aid the town of Madawaska to maintain roads in said  
4 town. Said sum to be expended under the direction of the  
5 county commissioners of Aroostook county.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Madawaska is exclusively a farming town and having no other industry.

It has more than one hundred miles of road to keep up and a number of small bridges.
