STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of deer in Androscoggin county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The month of October of each year is hereby
2 made an open month for the hunting and killing of deer in
3 the county of Androscoggin, under the same conditions and
4 restrictions as are provided in the general law of the state
5 relating to the taking and killing of deer in open season.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act
2 are hereby repealed.
